Church Background

Christ's Sanctified Holy Church is an association of churches established primarily on the principle that salvation is accomplished by two separate works of the grace of God through faith in Jesus Christ, the Son of God. The first work of grace is repentance toward God, or asking for forgiveness of the sins that we have committed. The second work is the baptism of the Holy Ghost, or sanctification, which is the indwelling of the Holy Spirit, eradicating the nature of sin.

Our church was started in 1892, coming out of the Methodist Episcopal Church. The founders of CSHC believed they needed to return to the roots of Methodism, which were based on the teachings of John Wesley, that a Christian must not only have their sins forgiven, but must go on to be sanctified through a second work of grace in the life of the believer. The sanctified individual is then enabled to live a holy life through the power of the Holy Spirit, a life full of love and righteousness.
